

RETREAT LEADERSHIP INFORMATION SHEET

What YOU need to know to be on the Team!

Thank you for your interest in the Fall 2012 Retreat Leadership Class! Because this class has a history of having a lot of students wanting to sign up, it is more than likely that not all students will be able to participate. We will be accepting some alternates in case spots open up.

In order to be considered for the class, you must do the following:

- ✓ Fill out and turn in the application form by Wednesday, January 18 at 3:00pm. Anything received after that may not be accepted.
- ✓ When you turn in your form, sign up for an interview time. Interviews will be done either individually or in groups of 2-3 (if needed). The interviews will take place from Tuesday, January 17 through Friday, January 20, 2012. If you have an excused absence the day of your interview, you will be able to make it up. Otherwise, if you miss your meeting time, you will not be able to make up the interview session.
- ✓ Be able to attend the Retreat Leadership Overnight (tentatively scheduled for August 17-18, 2012) This is **required**.
- ✓ Be able to miss at least three school days for the team overnight, freshman, and sophomore retreats.
- ✓ You must have at least a 2.5 GPA in order to be considered for the team.

Here's what we are looking for in a member of the Retreat Leadership Class:

Someone who is/will be:

- Passionate about her part during the planning and implementing of various events and/or retreats that these classes will be putting on. Willing to be a team player!
- Committed, responsible and accountable for her actions. We need girls who work well in groups, are responsible for their share of the workload and will be **great** examples/role models of leadership to the rest of the team and the NDB community.
- Open to exploring and sharing her faith life/spirituality. Being a member of the class means one is more than just a leader, she is a spiritual leader - which means that she must be open to growing spiritually and emotionally. This experience is not just you providing leadership to your fellow NDB community, but also a time for you to grow and learn as well.
- **Most importantly, we need girls with open hearts and open minds!**
